# **SWIMMING LESSONS EVERY DAY**

We have started our swimming lessons. Please ensure that every child brings their togs and towel to school every day so they can participate and make progress in their swimming and water safety skills. Anyone unable to participate must have a note from home. We still teach swimming on rainy days as our pool is heated.

Please support these lessons; the recent Swim Safer Report has revealed nearly half (43%) of NZ kids don't attend swimming lessons and only 30% of parents reported they were confident their child has the skills to help themselves in a water emergency.

# **BUILDING WORK**

Over the holidays we had new carpet laid in the corridor and the principal's office. This completes our recarpeting programme, having now replaced all of the old carpets. This work was carried out by Ruapehu Flooring.
